Landscape Workshop

A three-day weekend workshop was held in June under the tutelage of Andrew Watson. Taking the works of Constable as a starting point Andrew discussed the technical and developmental techniques of landscape art ranging from classical to modernist styles. Using his skills in mixed media, Andrew then walked the class through initial sketches and drawings towards developing a more fully resolved works, continuing to utilise components and techniques undertaken in previous days.

The group of 12 developed scenes taken in "plein air" on the banks of the nearby River Tyne. All agreed that it was a very helpful and enjoyable experience. A small *ad hoc* show of work by each person at the end of the workshop demonstrated the level of development all had achieved.
